Re: Rating Letter for BLR of Hindustan Foods Limited

India Ratings and Research (Ind-Ra) has upgraded Hindustan Foods Limited's (HFL) Long-Term Issuer Rating to 'IND A+' from 'IND A'. The Outlook is Stable. The instrument-wise rating actions are as follows:
