Independent Auditor's Review Report on Consolidated unaudited financial results of Hindustan Foods Limited for the quarter and year to date pursuant to the Regulation 33 of the SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended.

To The Board of Directors of Hindustan Foods Limited

- 1. We have reviewed the accompanying Statement of consolidated unaudited financial results of Hindustan Foods Limited (hereinafter referred to as 'the Holding Company'), its subsidiaries, (the Holding Company and its subsidiaries together referred to as the 'Group') and its share of the net loss after tax and total comprehensive loss of its associate for the quarter ended September 30, 2025 and the year to-date results for the period from April 01, 2025 to September 30, 2025 ('the Statement'), attached herewith, being submitted by the Holding Company pursuant to the requirements of Regulation 33 of the Securities and Exchange Board of India (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations, 2015, as amended ('the Regulations').
- 2. This Statement, which is the responsibility of the Holding Company's Management and has been approved by the Holding Company's Board of Directors, has been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Indian Accounting Standard 34 'Interim Financial Reporting', prescribed under Section 133 of the Companies Act, 2013('the Act'), read with relevant rules issued thereunder ('Ind AS 34') and other recognized accounting principles generally accepted in India and is in compliance with the Regulations. Our responsibility is to express a conclusion on the Statement based on our review.
- 3. We conducted our review of the Statement in accordance with the Standard on Review Engagements (SRE) 2410, 'Review of Interim Financial Information Performed by the Independent Auditor of the Entity' issued by the Institute of Chartered Accountants of India. A review of interim financial information consists of making inquiries, primarily of persons responsible for financial and accounting matters, and applying analytical and other review procedures. A review is substantially less in scope than an audit conducted in accordance with Standards on Auditing specified under section 143(10) of the Act and consequently does not enable us to obtain assurance that we would become aware of all significant matters that might be identified in an audit. Accordingly, we do not express an audit opinion.

We also performed procedures in accordance with the circular issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India under Regulation 33 (8) of the Regulations, to the extent applicable.

Based on our review conducted and procedures performed as stated in paragraph 3 above and based on the consideration of the review reports of the other auditor referred to in paragraph 6 below, nothing has come to our attention that causes us to believe that the accompanying Statement, prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles laid down in Ind AS 34 and other recognised accounting principles generally accepted in India, has not disclosed the information required to be disclosed in terms of the Regulations, including the manner in which it is to be disclosed, or that it contains any material misstatement.
- 6. We did not review the interim financial information of two subsidiaries included in the Statement, whose interim financial information (before consolidation adjustment) reflects total assets of Rs. 439.60 Crores as at September 30, 2025, and total revenues of Rs. 158.36 Crores and Rs. 286.36 Crores, total net profit after tax of Rs. 4.28 Crores and 0.76 Crores and total comprehensive income of Rs. 4.23 Crores and 0.69 Crores for the quarter ended September 30, 2025, and for the period from April 01, 2025, to September 30, 2025, respectively, and cash flows (net) of (Rs.4.27) Crores for the period from April 01, 2025, to September 30, 2025, as considered in the statement. These interim financial information have been reviewed by other auditor whose reports have been furnished to us by the management and our conclusion in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on the report of such other auditor and the procedures performed by us as stated in paragraph 3 above.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of the above matter with respect to our reliance on the work done by and report of the other auditor.

7. The Statement includes the interim financial information of two subsidiaries which have not been reviewed by their auditors, whose interim financial information (before consolidation adjustment) reflects total assets of Rs. 198.37 Crores as at September 30, 2025, and total revenue of Rs. 33.51 Crores and Rs. 71.18 Crores, total net loss after tax of Rs. 1.62 Crores and Rs. 1.73 Crores and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 1.64 Crores and Rs. 1.77 Crores for the quarter ended September 30, 2025, and for the period from April 01, 2025, to September 30, 2025, respectively, and cash flows (net) of (Rs. 4.49) Crores for the period from April 01, 2025, to September 30, 2025, as considered in the statement. The Statement also includes the Group's share of net loss after tax of Rs. 0.11 Crores and total comprehensive loss of Rs. 0.11 Crores for the period from August 21, 2025, to September 30, 2025, as considered in the Statement, in respect of associate, whose interim financial information has not been reviewed. This interim financial information have been furnished to us by the Management and our conclusion on the Statement in so far as it relates to the amounts and disclosures included in respect of these subsidiaries is based solely on such management prepared unaudited interim financial information. According to the information and

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explanations given to us by the Management, these interim financial information are not material to the Group.

Our conclusion is not modified in respect of the above matter with respect to our reliance on the financial result certified by the management.

STATEMENT OF UNAUDITED CONSOLIDATED FINANCIAL RESULTS FOR THE QUARTER AND SIX MONTHS ENDED SEPTEMBER 30, 2025

Notes to the unaudited consolidated financial results:

- 1) The unaudited consolidated financial results of Hindustan Foods Limited ("The Holding Company") and its subsidiaries (together referred to as "the Group") for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2025 have been duly reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on November 12, 2025. The Statutory Auditors of the Holding Company have expressed an unmodified conclusion on the above unaudited consolidated financial results. These unaudited consolidated financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles provided in Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 34 on 'Interim Financial Reporting', the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act), as applicable and guidelines issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) under SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended.
- 2) The Group is predominantly engaged in a single business segment which is "Contract Manufacturing" and the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM) reviews the operations of the Group as contract manufacturing. Consequently, no separate segment information has been furnished as per Ind AS 108 "Operating segments".
- 3) On September 24, 2024, the Board of directors of the Holding Company had approved the Composite Scheme of Arrangement and Amalgamation for de-merger of Contract Manufacturing (Nashik) Business of Avalon Cosmetics Private Limited and Amalgamation of Vanity Case India Private Limited with the Holding Company with effect from the appointment date April 1, 2024 and October 1, 2024 respectively. The Holding Company has received the approval of Bombay Stock Exchange and National Stock Exchange and now is in the process of getting the required approval from National Company Law Tribunal.
- 4) The Holding Company on August 21, 2025 has acquired 24,643 Series B CCPS aggregating to 25.07% of Asar Green Kabadi Private Limited for a total consideration is Rs. 5 crores, out of which Rs. 4 crores paid as a Cash consideration and the balance investment amounting to Rs. 1 crore has been adjusted against the outstanding Loan provided by the holding Company to Asar Green Kabadi Private Limited.
- 5) The Holding Company had revised the issue proceeds to Rs. 377.50 crore from Rs. 400.00 crore vide board resolution dated June 18, 2025 as one of the warrant holder, had not exercised the option to convert 5,32,009 warrants into equity shares. Subsequently, the objects of issue proceeds has been further amended, vide shareholders resolution dated September 23, 2025, by reclassifying Rs. 50.00 crore between objects. All proceeds have been utilized as per the offer document and revised issue proceeds as approved by the board of directors and shareholders of the Holding Company.
- The Shareholders of the Holding Company by special resolution on April 10, 2025 approved the Employee Stock Option Scheme 2025 ('ESOP Scheme 2025") of the Holding Company and its extension to the subsidiaries of the Holding Company. National Stock Exchange of India Limited and BSE Limited (Stock Exchanges) vide their letter dated July 04, 2025 granted its 'In-Principal' approval for listing of maximum of 10,00,000 Equity Shares of Rs. 2 each which may arise out of exercise of options as and when exercised from time to time subject to the prescribed conditions. During the quarter, the Holding Company has granted 1,47,100 options under ESOP Scheme 2025 on July 28, 2025, approved by Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Board.
- 7) Subsequent to the quarter ended September 30, 2025, HFL Consumer Products Private Limited ("HFL Consumer"), a Wholly Owned Subsidiary of the Holding Company has executed a Business Transfer agreement with a) M/s Ashish Industries and b) M/s Vijay for acquisition of two manufacturing facilities situated at Sinnar, Nashik, Maharashtra on slump sale and going concern basis.
- 8) Previous period/ year figures have been re-grouped, re-arranged and re-classified wherever necessary to conform to current period's classification.
- 9) From the December 2024 quarter, the Group has changed presentation denomination from "Rs in Lacs" to "Rs in Crores". Accordingly, the figures for the corresponding quarter/period of the previous year have been re-presented in "Rs in Crores".

Notes to the unaudited standalone financial results:

- 1) The unaudited standalone financial results of Hindustan Foods Limited ("Company") for the quarter and six months ended September 30, 2025 have been duly reviewed by the Audit Committee and approved by the Board of Directors at its meeting held on November 12, 2025. The Statutory Auditors of the Company have expressed an unmodified conclusion on the above unaudited standalone results. These unaudited Standalone financial results have been prepared in accordance with the recognition and measurement principles provided in Indian Accounting Standard (Ind AS) 34 on 'Interim Financial Reporting', the provisions of the Companies Act, 2013 (the Act), as applicable and guidelines issued by the Securities and Exchange Board of India (SEBI) under SEBI (Listing Obligations and Disclosure Requirements) Regulations 2015, as amended.
- 2) The Company is predominantly engaged in a single business segment which is "Contract Manufacturing" and the Chief Operating Decision Maker (CODM) reviews the operations of the Company as contract manufacturing. Consequently, no separate segment information has been furnished as per Ind AS 108 "Operating Segments".
- 3) On September 24, 2024, the Board of directors of the Company had approved the Composite Scheme of Arrangement for de-merger of Contract Manufacturing (Nashik) Business of Avalon Cosmetics Private Limited and Amalgamation of Vanity Case India Private Limited with the Company with effect from the appointment date April 1, 2024 and October 1, 2024 respectively. The Company has received the approval of Bombay Stock Exchange and National Stock Exchange and now is in the process of getting the required approval from National Company Law Tribunal.
- 4) The Company on August 21, 2025 has acquired 24,643 Series B CCPS aggregating to 25.07% of Asar Green Kabadi Private Limited for a total consideration is Rs. 5 crores, out of which Rs. 4 crores paid as a Cash consideration and the balance investment amounting to Rs. 1 crore has been adjusted against the outstanding Loan provided by the Company to Asar Green Kabadi Private Limited.
- 5) The Company had revised the issue proceeds to Rs. 377.50 crore from Rs. 400.00 crore vide board resolution dated June 18, 2025 as one of the warrant holder, had not exercised the option to convert 5,32,009 warrants into equity shares. Subsequently, the objects of issue proceeds has been further amended, vide shareholders resolution dated September 23, 2025, by reclassifying Rs. 50.00 crore between objects. All proceeds have been utilized as per the offer document and revised issue proceeds as approved by the board of directors and shareholders.
- The Shareholders by special resolution on April 10, 2025 approved the Employee Stock Option Scheme 2025 ('ESOP Scheme 2025") of the Company and its extension to the subsidiaries of the Company. National Stock Exchange of India Limited and BSE Limited (Stock Exchanges) vide their letter dated July 04, 2025 granted its 'In-Principal' approval for listing of maximum of 10,00,000 Equity Shares of Rs. 2 each which may arise out of exercise of options as and when exercised from time to time subject to the prescribed conditions. During the quarter, The Company has granted 1,47,100 options under ESOP Scheme 2025 on July 28, 2025, approved by Nomination and Remuneration Committee of the Board.
- Previous period/year figures have been re-grouped, re-arranged and re-classified wherever necessary to conform to current period's classification.
- 8) From the December 2024 quarter, the Company has changed presentation denomination from "Rs in Lacs" to "Rs in Crores". Accordingly, the figures for the corresponding quarter/period of the previous year have been re-presented in "Rs in Crores".
